Dear Parents, in view of the ongoing MCO, and after extensive consultation with parents and teachers, NURI will be coming up with several new measures.

- April and May 2020 school fees to be reduced to RM 120 for all levels.
- New “Teachers Salary Relief Fund” set up for parents willing to contribute.

Message to NURI Parents

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hear you and we understand what some of you are going through. The current COVID 19 situation has resulted in tough times for many of our parents and as such, we have made the important decision to lessen the financial burden on our parents by reducing the monthly school fees to a token RM 120 - E-Learners and retainment fee.

However, this COVID 19 situation has also affected many small businesses as well. Despite our most optimistic forecast and after factoring in Government aid, NURI will have to undergo a period of cost reduction to keep all the teachers, principals and support staff employed. As of the 1st of March 2020, directors' salaries have been reduced to 0 and starting from 1st of May 2020, teachers, principals and support staff salaries will be reduced appropriately to sustain operations.

As such, I am personally appealing to parents who can afford to continue to pay the full school fees or any amount up to or in excess of the full school fees. The

amount paid beyond the RM 120 will be moved into a NURI Teachers Salary Relief Fund that will make up for the shortfall for reduction in teacher's salaries. Your gesture of goodwill will be deeply appreciated by the teachers and will be officially acknowledged in the respective NURI Schools and by NURI Head Office. Your principal will be in touch with you personally, please do indicate if you are willing to contribute.

Everybody at NURI thanks you for your continual support and together, we will emerge from this stronger and provide a more robust learning environment for your children.

April and May Fees 2020

A detailed breakdown is as follows:

- All fees for all levels are reduced to a minimum of **RM 120** for April 2020 and **RM 120** for May 2020. Sibling rates, facilities fees and all similar additions and deductions are not applicable.
- These fees will be used to support our E-Learners Platform and talent retainment.
- Should school resume in May 2020, fees will be adjusted accordingly. If school remains closed, May 2020 fees will remain at RM 120.
- Parents who have paid in excess will be able to carry forward the amount to subsequent months payments.

Teachers Salary Relief Fund

(Enhanced Contributions for April and May 2020)

A detailed breakdown is as follows:


- Parents who like our work and would like to support our teachers can do so by continuing to pay the full school fees or any amount up to or in excess of the full school fees.
- All school fees paid beyond the RM 120 will be moved to the Teachers Salary Relief Fund.
- This fund will be used to supplement teachers' loss in income from cost reductions.
- All contributions will be officially acknowledged in the respective NURI Schools and by NURI Head Office.
